Here is a recap of our projects this past year:

**Homecoming Food Truck** – we sponsored a good truck at the 2024 Homecoming and earned a percentage of their profit (\$280).

<u>Football Squares</u> – Thanks to Molly for suggesting this new idea and owning it! We earned \$1,000 from the Ohio State vs Michigan game. The committee will decide if we want to do this again in the fall. <u>Holiday Wreath Sale</u> – Our online sale earned us \$8 per order which raised \$304. This is an easy fundraiser and worthwhile.

<u>Pampered Chef</u> – Our final profit for the Pampered Chef fundraiser was \$288.60. The check was lost in the mail and a replacement is in process. Since this is pending, we are not counting this in the budget. <u>Prize Calendar Raffle</u> – This was a great success, thanks to everyone! So many of you solicited or donated prizes and sold or bought tickets. We earned \$5,297.49! Special thanks to Karen Hirsh for posting the winners on Facebook, and to Debbie Hill for delivering the prizes.

<u>Dean's Plant Sale</u> – Our annual plant sale is a favorite. The price we charge for the plants is less than what is charged in the store, so this is a Win-Win! The final numbers are pending, so we are estimating our profit to be a minimum of \$1,000. Thanks to Sharon McManamon for organizing this!

<u>Golf Outing</u> – The event last summer raised \$2,775. Save the date for August 16, 2025. Details will be provided soon regarding sponsorship opportunities, sign-ups to play, and volunteering on the day of the event.
